2018 Highlights

Access Now makes a significant difference in the community by providing specialty medical care to the uninsured.

In 2018:

We referred 2,523 patients to more than 1,000 physicians and other health professionals and three hospital systems for the complex care they needed.

We received 3,964 referral requests for specialty medical care.

Our staff coordinated more than 11,000 office appointments and hospital procedures.

Physicians and other healthcare professionals donated care conservatively valued at more than \$ 5.4 million.

Where Insurance Ends, Access Now Begins

In 2018, Virginia expanded Medicaid, changing eligibility rules. Now, those at or below 138 percent of the federal poverty level may be eligible, even if they'd applied and been denied in the past.

But there still are thousands who fall through the cracks, who have nowhere else to turn for specialty care. Maybe they couldn't complete the forms. Maybe some who qualified will lose Medicaid coverage throughout the year, if they get a raise and go over the income limit. **We understand that access to insurance does not always mean access to care.**

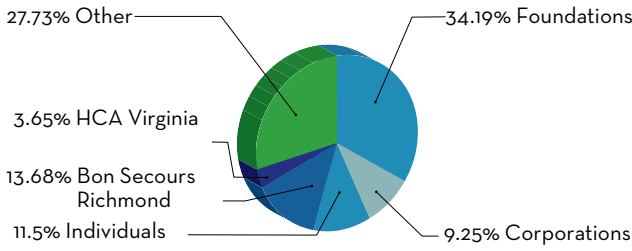
That's why Access Now remains so vital in our communities.

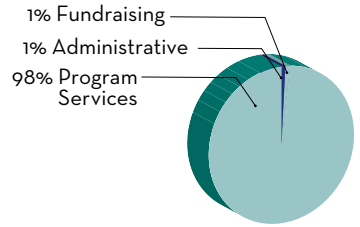

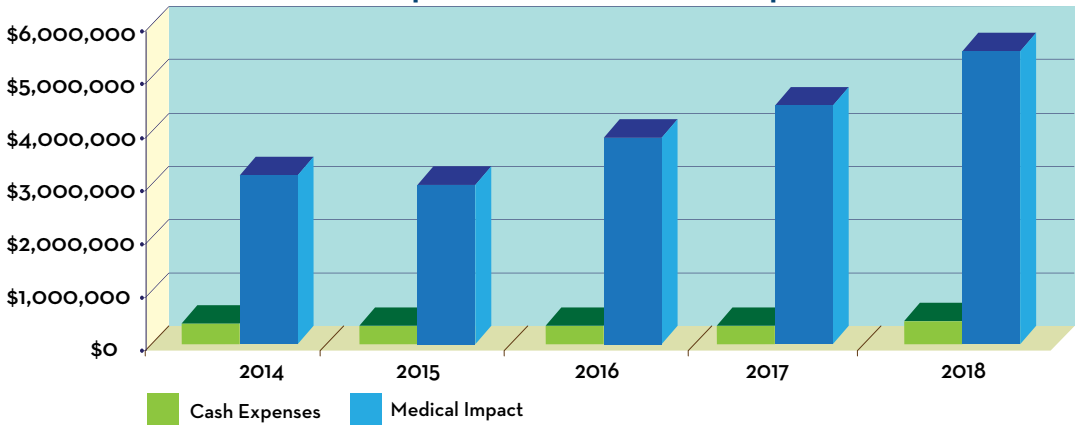
2018 Operating Revenues (audited)
