A <u>recent study from Harvard</u> showed that 26 percent of seriously ill patients report being denied some type of needed treatment because of the type of - or lack of - insurance they have.

While nine in ten of these patients have health insurance, about a third said they had problems paying their medical bills.

Medicaid Expansion + Access Now = Care for All

On Nov. 1, Virginians who qualify for **Medicaid health insurance coverage** under the state's expansion program began enrolling for coverage beginning in January.

About 400,000 people in the state are newly eligible as Medicaid extends coverage to 138 percent of the federal poverty level, which is up to \$16,754 for an individual or \$28,677 for a family of three annually.

But unfortunately, there still will be thousands of people who fall through the cracks. Others may receive Medicaid one year but lose it another. That's where Access Now comes in.

At Access Now, we are building upon lessons learned from the Affordable Care Act (aka Obamacare) that **access to insurance does not automatically equate to access to care**. As patients lost access to health insurance, they mistakenly believed they were no longer eligible to receive care through the safety net and became lost to care. We are currently educating clients to come back in the event they lose Medicaid coverage.

We'll be here to ensure that Central Virginians always get the care they need.
